Dear Club Member,

This is a review and update of the club procedures.

Membership

Monthly dues are due in advance. A late fee (\$5) is assessed if payment is not received by the 10th of the month and is added to the following month's dues. Three consecutive months of nonpayment of dues results in loss of membership.

All guests need to be listed in the Pro Shop. The guest fee is \$10 for adults and \$5 for juniors. Special arrangements can be made if you have out-of-town guests for an extended visit. The same person living in the greater Fallbrook area can be a guest up to six times a year. A sponsoring member will receive one free month's dues after three months of the new membership.

Court procedures

Court sign up on the board is required prior to play even at slow times. Play time is limited to one hour for Doubles, 45 minutes for Singles and 30 minutes for practice, when others are waiting. All players for the court must be present before sign up, i.e., for singles both players must be present before signing up, for doubles all four players need to be present before signing up for a court.

If the courts are all in play when you arrive, sign in with the time. When the playtime elapses the first complete group on the waiting list has priority and should go to the court. You cannot bump anyone when another court is available. If courts are wet, signup time will be entered when the court is ready to play, not an estimated time.

Courts 1 thru 3 are match play courts during the morning hours; no practice or training sessions. Courts 5 and 6 are teaching/practice courts. Juniors may sign up and have full court privileges on courts 5 thru 10.

Special days, i.e. Men's, Ladies, Mixed, as well as exchanges, tournaments, leagues and socials are noted on the monthly calendar and on the signup board. These activities have priority. Our monthly calendar and newsletter are also on our website at fallbrooktennisclub.com.

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After Hours

Due to night visitors and vandalism, the court lights may not be used after 9:30 p.m. Unless special arrangements are made. Anyone on the premises after this time is subject to arrest for trespassing.

Please turn off the court lights after play, unless players are waiting for your court. (There is a warmup time required by the lights after they have been switched on. Do not switch lights off and on, it shortens the lamp life.)

Parents, please make it clear to your children that the tennis club is not a night party area. Also, your children may not bring guests without payment of guest fees.

Supervision of small children is the responsibility of the parents who bring them to the tennis club. If the children are disruptive to the matches, parents will be asked to take them home.

Attire

Shirts are required for all players in keeping with proper attire on the courts. Tennis shoes that do not leave marks are required.

Parking

Please note the upper parking lot closes at 5 p.m. Monday through Friday and 3 p.m. Saturday and Sunday, unless a special event is scheduled. Please lock the gate when you are the last departing vehicle in either parking lot regardless of what time of day. This is especially important on the weekends.

Also note that traffic is two way on the driveway to the upper parking. Please be courteous.
